

Durrumbul Public School Durrumbul Public School is located six kilometres west of Mullumbimby in a rural setting. Durrumbul is a small school with a long history of providing a quality education with a focus on the whole child. The school motto, learning, respect, caring underpin the school student welfare and learning programs. Students come from culturally diverse backgrounds including farming, small business. professional and trades people, single parent families, and families from overseas who share a common commitment to a small school education for their children. The community works with the school to nurture a love of learning and develop the unique potential of every child.
