Ensure learning is data driven and based on formative assessment practices and learning continuums/progressions. An increased 10% of students in top 2 bands in Literacy and numeracy in NAPLAN. Timely, targeted intervention and feedback for all students reflects best practice and students access tailored support, extension or enrichment to maximise outcomes. Internal and external growth data shows consistent improvement for every student.
